





Thank you very much for your fax concerning the Sydney/Hobart race.

To let you know our comments we are looking for the detailed information that we will hopefully get, when the test report will follow.

Meanwhile we want to stress, that the demand for SOLAS life rafts will not solve the problem, from our point of view. Our life rafts are designed in size per person, tube volume per person, size of anti-capsizing water pockets to SOLAS standard. But we think, that also SOLAS life rafts will capsize in such a rough sea.

RE: Sydney Hobart race, Pro Saver life raft

First of all I have to say, that a I have not received any detailed test report so it is hardly possible to judge the situation.

Therefore I can only estimate what happened with the life raft. The information we share up to now indicates that due to a wrong action – cutting a hole in the floor – the life raft lost its stability and shape.

The principle of construction is based on the floor as a major part which keeps the bent tubes in the shape that is needed for the stability.

By cutting a hole in the floor it is a question of time that the life raft will loose its function.

The recommended action in such a situation (capsizing and extreme weather conditions) would be to turn the life raft in the normal position and float with water up to the upper tube. The result is additional weight and therefore the risk of capsizing is minimized.

The destruction of the life rafts is not a result of malfunction of the life raft it is a result of mishandling (hole in the floor).
