## INQUEST INTO THE DEATHS IN THE 1998 SYDNEY TO HOBART YACHT RACE

## STATEMENT OF LORRAINE GABLE

On April 2000 I, **LORRAINE GABLE** of Unit 5, 52 Darling Point Road, Darling Point in the State of New Wales, Function Manager, say:

- 1. In 1998 I was the Function Manager at the Cruising Yacht Club of Australia ("CYCA").
- Prior to and during the 1998 Sydney to Hobart Yacht Race ("SHYR") there was a sticker on my CYCA telephone which had contact numbers for key people for the 1998 SHYR. As far as I am aware all telephones in the CYCA had this sticker on them.
- As far as I am aware anyone telephoning the CYCA and asking for Phil Thompson's
  mobile number would have been given it as that is one of the numbers which is on the
  sticker.
- 4. On 26 December 1998 I left the CYCA at approximately 11.00am on a spectator boat to watch the start of the 1998 SHYR.
- 5. The boat I was on followed the fleet out of Sydney Heads. The boat then returned to the CYCA marina. This trip took approximately 3 hours. I returned to the CYCA marina at approximately 2.30pm.
- 6. I remained on the deck of the CYCA marina for approximately 1 hour and then, went home, which would have been approximately 3.30pm.
- 7. I do not recall anyone saying, while I was standing on the deck of the marina, that someone from the Bureau of Meteorology had telephoned looking for Phil Thompson in relation to a storm warning or any other matter.
- At the time of the 1998 SHYR I did not know Ken Batt. My first contact with Ken Batt
  was in relation to organising safety seminars. The first safety seminar was held in
  June or July 1999.

9. I am no longer an employee of the CYCA. However, from June/July 1999 to March 2000 I spoke to Ken Batt approximately 6 to 12 times and have corresponded with him by letter and facsimile in relation to the safety seminars.
