INQUEST INTO THE DEATHS IN THE 1998 SYDNEY TO HOBART YACHT RACE

STATEMENT OF EMMA MIALL

On 20th April 2000, I, EMMA MIALL of 192 Queens Road, Woollahra in the State of New South Wales, student, say:

- 1. During the 1998 Sydney to Hobart Yacht Race ("SHYR") I was working in the Cruising Yacht Club of Australia ("CYCA") Bar as a part time bar attendant.
- 2. On 26 December 1998 I worked in the CYCA Bar from 3.00pm to midnight with a half hour break at 8.00pm.
- 3. I cannot recall which other female bar attendants were working at the CYCA Bar on 26 December 1998, although I am sure in the Cruising Yacht Club of Australia ("CYCA") Bar there were others. Most of the bar staff were working on that day.
- 4. To the best of my recollection, I did not receive a telephone call from anyone at the Bureau of Meteorology ("BoM") on the afternoon of 26 December 1998.
- 5. I am not aware of anyone else in the CYCA Bar who received a telephone call from anyone at BoM on the afternoon of 26 December 1998.
- 6. If someone had called the CYCA Bar and had asked to speak with Phil Thompson, I would have firstly, put that person through to his extension in the CYCA Sailing Office and, if he did not answer that call, then I would have transferred the call to my manager, Paul McTaggart.
- 7. When I left the CYCA Bar at midnight I had not received, nor was I aware that anyone else had received, a telephone call from BoM.
